PUBLICITY CHAIRPERSON

Overview: The Publicity Chair is responsible for writing and submitting monthly articles to various news organizations as well as other publicity-related projects as needed.

The Publicity Chairperson is not a voting member of the PLAL Board but should attend each monthly Board Meeting in order to report on publicity activities.

General Duties:

- Monthly articles include the Artist of the Month (AOM)/Jeweler of the Month (JOM) combined article for the Second Wednesday Reception and the Bay Club exhibiting artist.
- Monthly publications include the Port Ludlow Voice, the Port Townsend Leader, and the Peninsula Daily News.
- Other articles may include publicity for special events, League notifications, or any other project designated by the Board and submitted to specified outlets.

Publicity Article General Specifications:

The Port Ludlow Voice -

- 1. Articles should be limited to about 350 words: Title of article should be in *Times Roman, 14 pt. bold*, and text of article should be in *Times Roman, 12 pt.* When two articles are combined, no more than 700 words.
- Each articles ends with the standard paragraph stating the time and date of the Second Wednesday Reception, location, and League President's contact information.
- 3. Articles have to be submitted to the Voice editor by the 10th of each month, i.e. January 10th for February's publication (Bev Rothenborg, bevrothenborg@broadstripe.net).
- 4. Pictures are accepted along with the article.
- 5. Pictures have to be at least 300 dpi, in large format. Voice editor will size to fit the column.
- 6. Picture information should include: the artwork's title and the artist's name.
- 7. The picture pertinent information should be submitted to the Voice editor (Mary Ronen, ronenme@outlook.com) who will, in turn, submit it to the Voice photo editor (Bob Graham).

The Port Townsend Leader -

- 1. May be the same article as for the Voice but should be edited down to bare minimum.
- 2. Must be submitted 10 days prior to publication date, and before Wednesday, noon of the week prior to publication.
- 3. Pictures may accompany the article with the same requirements as for the Voice.
- 4. There is no guarantee that the article will be published. Since the Leader changed management, they are more restricted on space for "free" articles.
- 5. As of January, 2018, the Leader Art Editor is Katie Kowalski, arts@ptleader.com.

The Peninsula Daily News -

- 1. May be the same article as for the Voice but should be edited somewhat so that it is slightly different than the article sent to the Leader.
- 2. Must be submitted 8-10 days prior to the Sunday edition.
- 3. Pictures may accompany the article with the same requirements as for the Voice.
- 4. As of January, 2018, the Daily News art editor is Laura Lofgren news@peninsuladailynews.com.
