

SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRPERSON

Overview: The Scholarship Chair is responsible for presenting a list of qualified local candidates for the Board's consideration in awarding scholarships to those individuals who are graduating from local high school and are pursuing further education in the visual arts.

The Scholarship Chairperson is not a voting member of the PLAL Board but is welcome to attend monthly Board Meetings, especially during the scholarship candidate discovery process.

General Duties:

- Contacts local high school administrators to issue a call for student portfolios.
- Works with administrators to identify those students who are eligible to apply.
- Application deadline is May 1st.
- Screens the portfolios and presents them to the Board with any recommendations as to eligibility for the League scholarships.
- After the Board votes, notifies the administrators and students of the Board's determination.
- The school should be advised of the scholarship recipient by May 20th.
- Works with the League Treasurer in notifying the student of the process to receive the scholarship monies.
- Attends the school awards ceremonies to present the scholarships to the receiving graduates or finds a member to do the presentation, usually at an awards ceremony the first week of June.
